Thank you for getting involved in our Vintage Magazine Challenge.

## Here's what you need to do:

The challenge is very simple - the magazine you've been sent is your source material for your collages. Your challenge is to use that material to create five new collages, based on the themes below. You may add extra mediums, such as pen, pencil or paint. You can also add additional flat coloured paper from other sources. What you can't do is add any additional 'content' (pictures/typography/patterns etc.) from sources outside of the magazine.

We've enclosed five A5 substrates for you to use - however, you are welcome to use your own as well, if you prefer. Before you start, please take a good quality picture or scan of the front cover of your magazine.

You can choose five briefs from the following:

- A collage that represents the theme of your magazine
- · A collage that has no reference to the theme of your magazine
- · A monochromatic collage
- A typographic collage with a message/slogan
- A representational still life collage (subject of your choosing)
- · An abstract collage
- A portrait
- · A minimal collage
- · A collage of your choice

When you've completed your collages - please scan or photograph them in even light at a high resolution (300dpi), title them and email them, along with the picture of the front cover, to: submissions@contemporarycollagemagazine.com

Please send your collages to us within a month of recieving your challenge.
